Introduction to PatientCare 360

PatientCare 360 is a secure longitudinal health record platform that enables the electronic sharing and access of health information across participating healthcare organizations. The PatientCare 360 Portal is designed to provide authorized users with timely access to important patient information, regardless of where the data originates, supporting more coordinated and informed care delivery.

Contexture, in partnership with KPI Ninja by Health Catalyst, provides the PatientCare 360 Portal to support the secure exchange and aggregation of clinical information across the health information exchange participants. PatientCare 360 collects and organizes data from multiple healthcare systems and participating organizations to create a comprehensive, longitudinal patient record.


The platform integrates both clinical and administrative data from a variety of sources. This unified view of patient information allows clinicians, care managers, and healthcare administrators to access relevant patient data quickly and securely.

Through PatientCare 360, participating organizations can improve care coordination, enhance clinical decision-making, and support population health initiatives. By bringing together data from diverse sources into a single, accessible platform, PatientCare 360 enables care teams to better understand patient history, identify care needs, and deliver higher-quality care across the healthcare continuum.

Access and Login

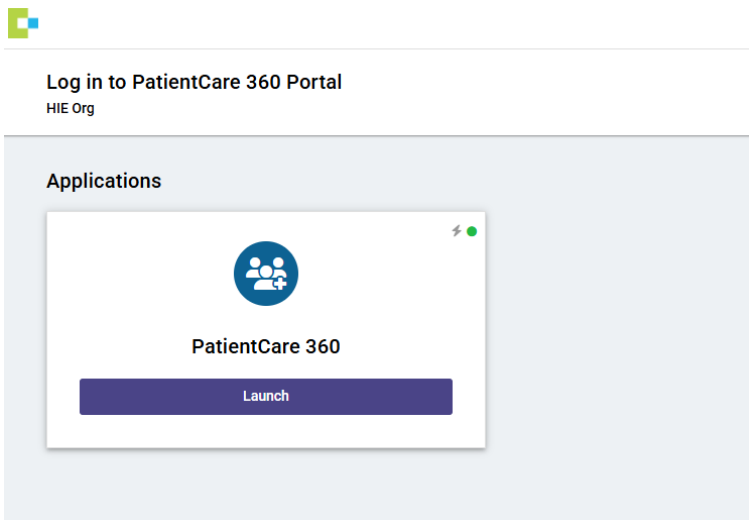
Steps:

1. Log into the Portal using your assigned credentials.

Send		Located in the top right corner of the Patient Details page, securely send selected patient data via secure mail.
Download		Located in the top right corner of the Patient Details page, download selected patient data into XML, HTML, or HTML Preview formats.
Print		Appears when documents can be printed or saved in a PDF format. The page printed may look different than what is displayed in the portal.

Patient Search

Search for a Patient

1. Enter the **Required** fields:
 - a. MRN (*exact search*) OR
 - b. Any **TWO**: Last Name, First Name, or Date of Birth (*wild card search*)
 - i. A minimum of 2 characters is required for this search to be completed
2. Utilize **Optional** or **Expanded** search fields to filter results:
 - a. **Optional** – SSN
 - b. **Expanded** – Phone number, gender, street address, city, state, and/or zip code
3. Patients matching the criteria, regardless of their consent status, will display.
4. Click the Patient Name link in the first column to view the Patient Details
 - a. If a patient has several MRN numbers, a plus sign will appear to the left of their name
 - b. **NOTE:** If a patient appears several times in the search results, the same data will appear regardless of the link that is clicked

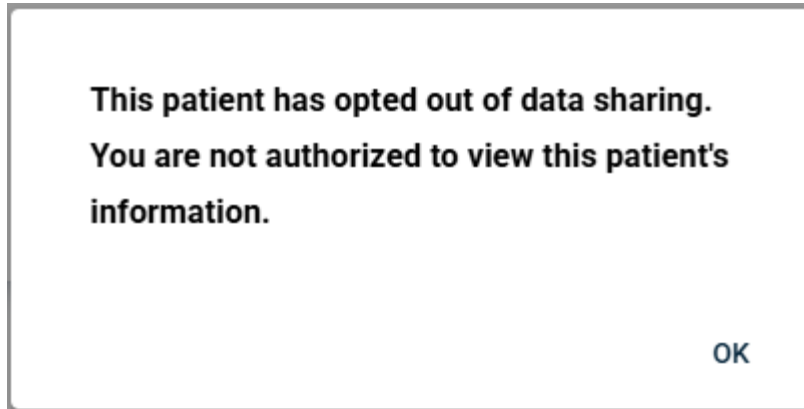

Visit History

IMPORTANT NOTE: When Visit History data is transmitted via HL7, you can select the link to view the Face Sheet and Visit Details. If the Visit History data is received through a CCD, the link will not be available. In this case, the information can be viewed under the CCD data tab.

Medications

The Medications subtab displays a history of reported medications from various sources.

It is separated into the following three sections:

- Provider CCDA: The medication noted in an encounter.
 - Selecting the Plus will show the dosage for the medication, if provided.
- Payer Prescription: The information displayed can include medication Last Fill date, Refill #, Medication/Strength, Prescribed By, Pharmacy, and Payer. The source data may vary, depending on contributing sources. The most typical source is MedicaidRx data.
- Pharmacy Orders: The patient's Pharmacy medication history.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Medications displayed in a red font are a controlled substance. The Medications tab only displays HL7 data. CCD data is not available in this view.

Immunizations

The Immunizations subtab displays the immunizations history, including messages from CCD and VXU. You can see the date of the immunization for all doses available, and you can see the completion status for an immunization. Additionally, you can see if an immunization was refused or if there were any contraindications or reactions.

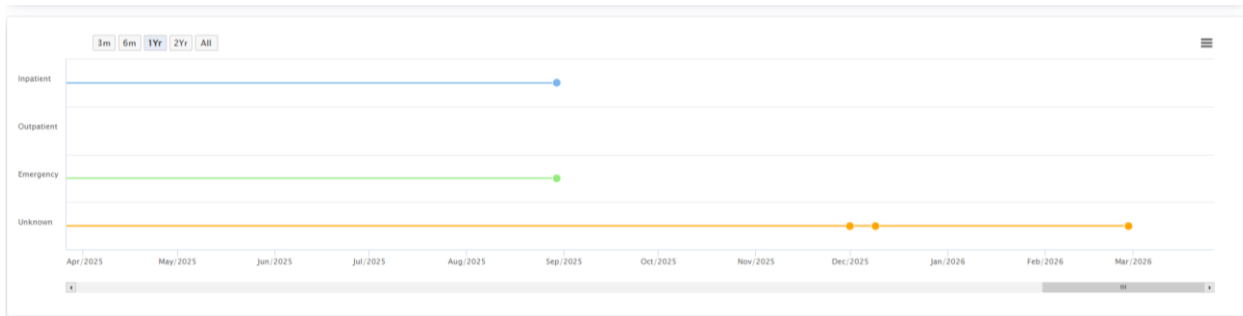
Encounter Timeline

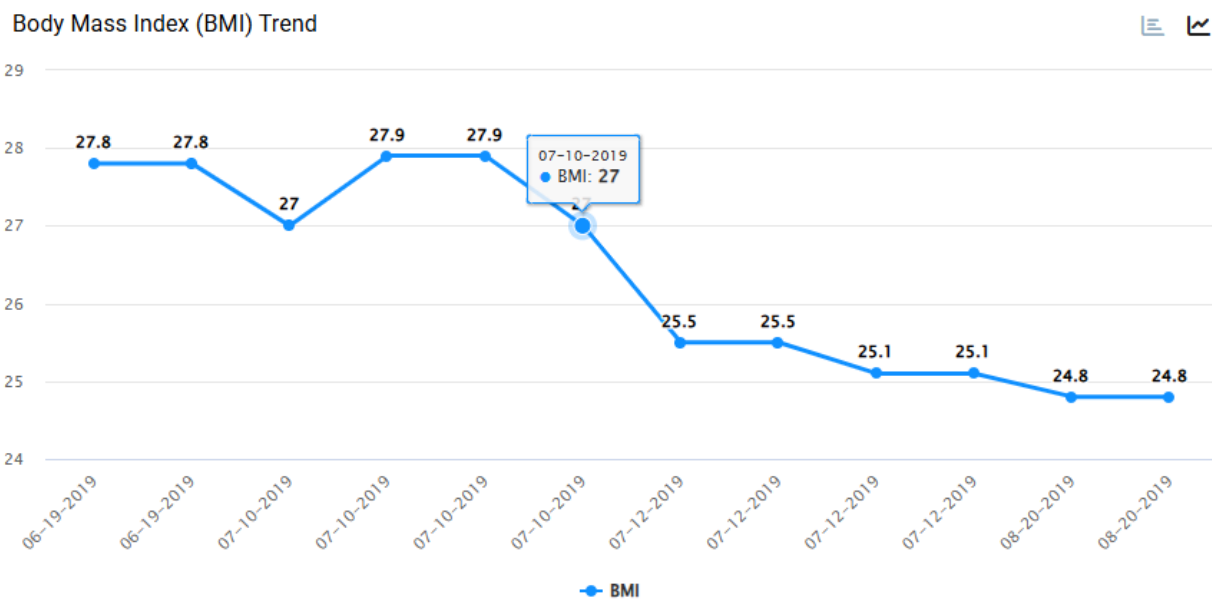

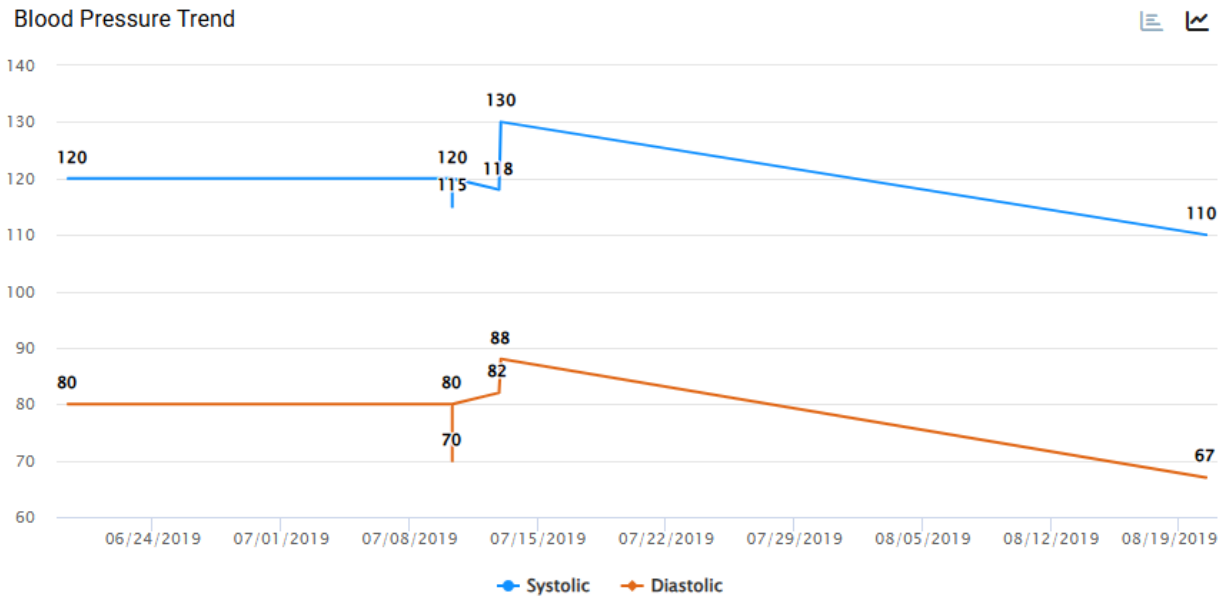

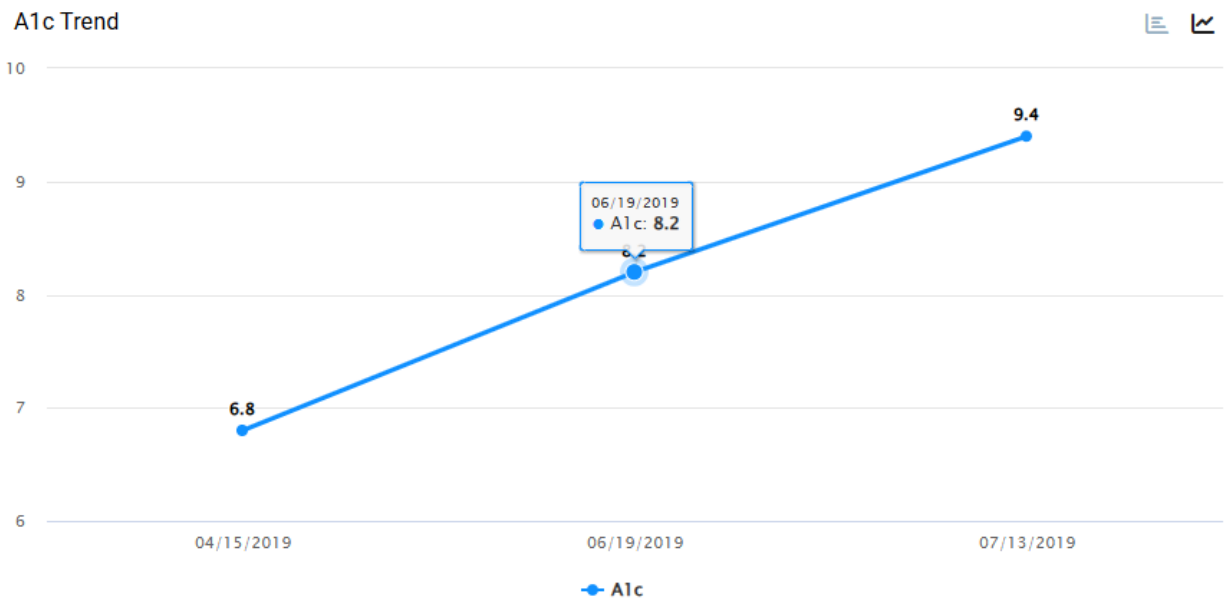

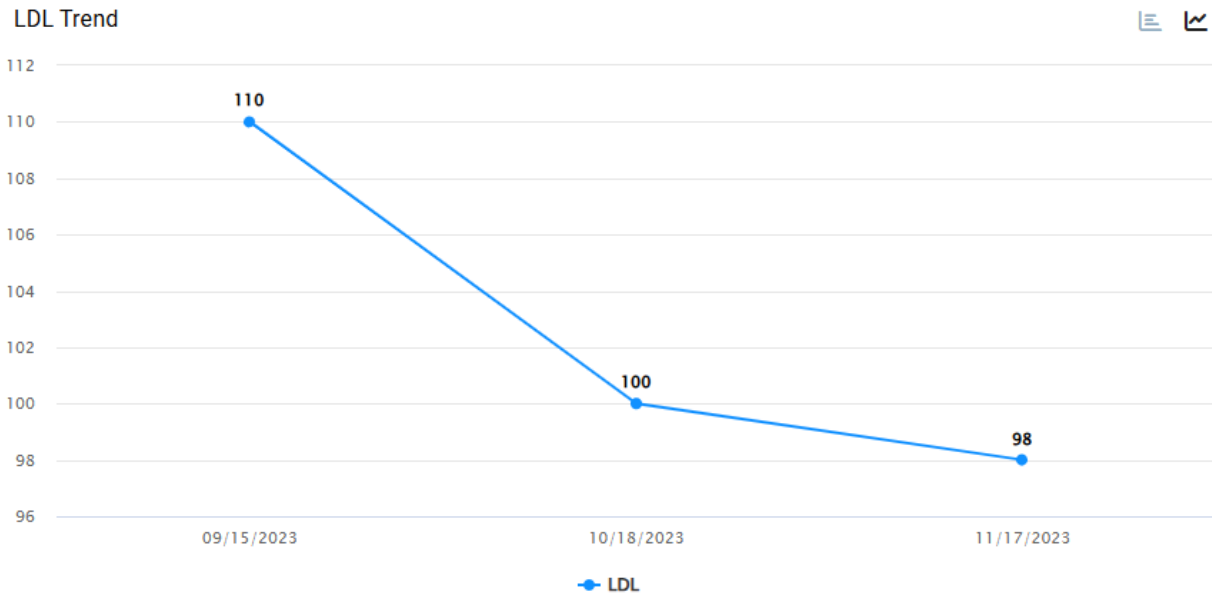
A1C Trend
